

# ISO 14001: Transition to the new 2015 standard

ISO 14001 is the most widely used environmental management system in the world. A new edition of the standard was published in 2015 which introduced a range of significant changes, many of which will be new to small and medium sized businesses.

The changes have made the standard a much more strategic tool to improve business and environmental performance, so whether you've been certified for a while or looking into it for the first time, the new 2015 standard offers a lot.

### **The changes to ISO 14001**

The new ISO 14001 standard has introduced some significant changes:

- A new structure including Annex SL
- New responsibilities for top management
- A requirement to consider "organisational context"
- An expanded scope to include a "life cycle perspective"
- Changes in required documentation

- How to best meet the new requirements?
- What do senior management need to know and do?
- When do you need to transition?
- How to best manage the audit.
